1. Return the attached form with your details
2. Attend our Scare Academy Training Session on either Sunday 16 or Sunday 23 September
3. Attend the Dress Rehearsal on Thursday 11 October from 5.30pm (for about 3-4 hours)
4. Commit to a minimum of three nights scaring during the duration of the event (Oct 12-Nov 3) - at least one night during the first week (Oct 12 to 19).

What kind of scare might I be doing?

We have a number of different kinds of scares, requiring different skills and giving a different kind of experience. We will assign scarers a position based on skills etc. The scares might involve:

- Operating mechanics/technical equipment- hidden inside
- Operating mechanics/technical equipment – hidden outside
- Costumed scaring- silent/still
- Costumed scaring- active
- Character
- Marshall

Will I have to be in the dark?

Most scares involve being in the dark. If you are not comfortable with this, it's probably not for you.

Will I be on my own?

Although scarers are often in talking/calling distance of each other they will often be operating on their own.

What will the conditions be like?

Different scares have different conditions. Some require being outside for long periods of time, some are in confined spaces, some require being still or great attention to make sure the timing is got right. But they are all fun! It's wonderful hearing the laughter and screams of people as a result of a scare that you've operated. If you are particularly adverse to a condition we will do our best to place you on a scare that suits you.

Do I need to attend the training, I'm really busy?

Sorry, all potential scarers need to attend our training sessions. They are part of our selection procedure.

Do I need to attend the dress rehearsal?

All scarers need to attend the dress rehearsal so they can see where exactly they will be, and what they need to do on the night.

What do you provide for us on the night?

On the night we provide scarers with:

- Food and drink before the event starts;
- Hot food after the event has finished;
- Costume-if necessary

What time would we need to arrive each night to scare?

You must be willing to arrive for 5.30pm for the team meeting prior to the event starting.

How long does the scaring take?

You need to scare from the start of the event til the end - sometimes the first group enters at 6.30pm and the last group might not leave until midnight. We may try and swap scarers on the more demanding positions during the evening.
